
A Message from the Prez.

Just a reminder, hotel reservations for the spring tour must be made by March 31st. The hotel will release any remaining rooms on April 1st.






enthusiasts in October 1915 took place on the front steps of the Art Institute building. The Art Institute was founded as the Chicago Academy of Fine Arts in 1879. The name was changed in 1882, and shortly after, the institution was already in need of a new home for its expanding collection and growing student body. As the city prepared to dazzle the country as host of the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition, the Art Institute's trustees negotiated with the city's civic bodies for a new structure located on a park site at Michigan Avenue and Adams Street. The Art Institute officially opened their classical Beaux-Arts style building on December 8, 1893. Since then the building and the Art Institute have been a treasure in Chicago on Michigan Avenue and the Dixie Highway.


The night before the Spring Trip we will have an opportunity to attend this event. It will be a chance to see Jon Lisota's first efforts in the field of Drama!


