The Dixmoor Golf Club was one of a number of golf courses along the Dixie Highway in the Homewood area. Located south of 175th Street and west of Dixie highway, the club was across the street from the Calumet Country Club and just north of the Ravisloe Country Club grounds. Although, incorporated in October 1921, the course celebrated its inaugural season in May 1923. The club was semiprivate and the general public was welcome to use the course for a daily fee. Notable members included renowned amateur golfer Charles "Chick" Evans, Charles Comiskey, owner of the Chicago White Sox, and William Veeck, Sr., president of the Chicago Cubs. The club struggled financially and closed at the end of the 1926 season. The acreage was sold for development but only a dozen homes were built before the onset of the Depression. It wasn't until the post-WWII housing boom that the subdivision, now known as Governors Park, in tribute to another famous highway, was completed.

This tells us that our key switch, or the wire feeding the points is bad. So we dropped the dash panel and checked the switch. We had voltage going into the switch. Turned the key and we had voltage coming out of the switch. So this tells us that the wire going to the distributer is grounding out or broken.

In Joe's case the wire broke where it attaches to the plug that screws into the distributer.

So into my little black bag I go and install a new switch and cable.

Joe and Mar were then on their way to eat pizza with the rest of the group.
